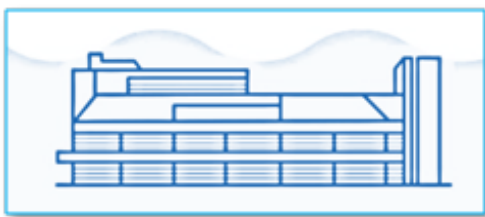

## Overview

If you are working on English for your career, students can choose a Gap Year programme to maximise exposure to academic English and study business modules in the afternoons.

Combining a gap year with business studies can be an excellent way to gain real-world experience, enhance your skills, and build a strong foundation for your future career in business. Students who complete a business module with us may be eligible for exemptions of similar modules in their home universities.

Learners have the opportunity to choose academic modules (30 ECTS total) from Galway Business School's undergraduate programmes, and support these modules with 15 hours of English classes.

## Levels & Availability

Suitable for **18+**

Minimum level **B1+ to B2**

Start Dates: **September** or **January**

Gap Year and Semester Abroad commences in February and September of each year in line with the academic intake. Students will receive their individual timetables, once they choose which modules they wish to study.

## Course Details

- **Business Modules**

You will have access to a wide selection of academic modules offered from a range of business disciplines including: marketing, sales, business, entrepreneurship, accounting, computer applications.

Maximum modules chosen per semester to the value of 30 ECTS (modules available have 5 ECTS or 10 ECTS each).
