Overview

Our Erasmus+ programmes are designed for teachers (primary, secondary and tertiary level) who teach subjects through English or plan to teach in English. These courses inspire participants to upskill, broaden their expertise and bring new energy, ideas, and approaches to their schools, enriching learning both inside and outside the classroom.

Programme Details

CLIL (Primary Teachers)

Start dates: July 13th & October 19th 2026

This course helps teachers integrate language-supportive methodologies into their lessons making learning more inclusive and engaging. Participants explore practical strategies to enhance young learners' language acquisition through hands-on workshops and guidance on creating engaging, language-rich classroom materials.

CLIL (Secondary Teachers)

Start dates: April 13th & July 20th 2026

Designed for secondary educators, this Erasmus+ course focuses on applying CLIL methodology to teach subject content in a foreign language. Participants learn to craft engaging, language-rich CLIL-based lessons, harness digital tools, and overcome the unique challenges of teaching at secondary level.

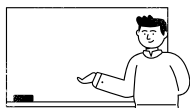

EdTech: Smart Solutions for Smarter Teaching

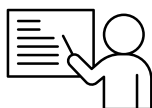
Start dates: June 22nd & October 19th 2026
